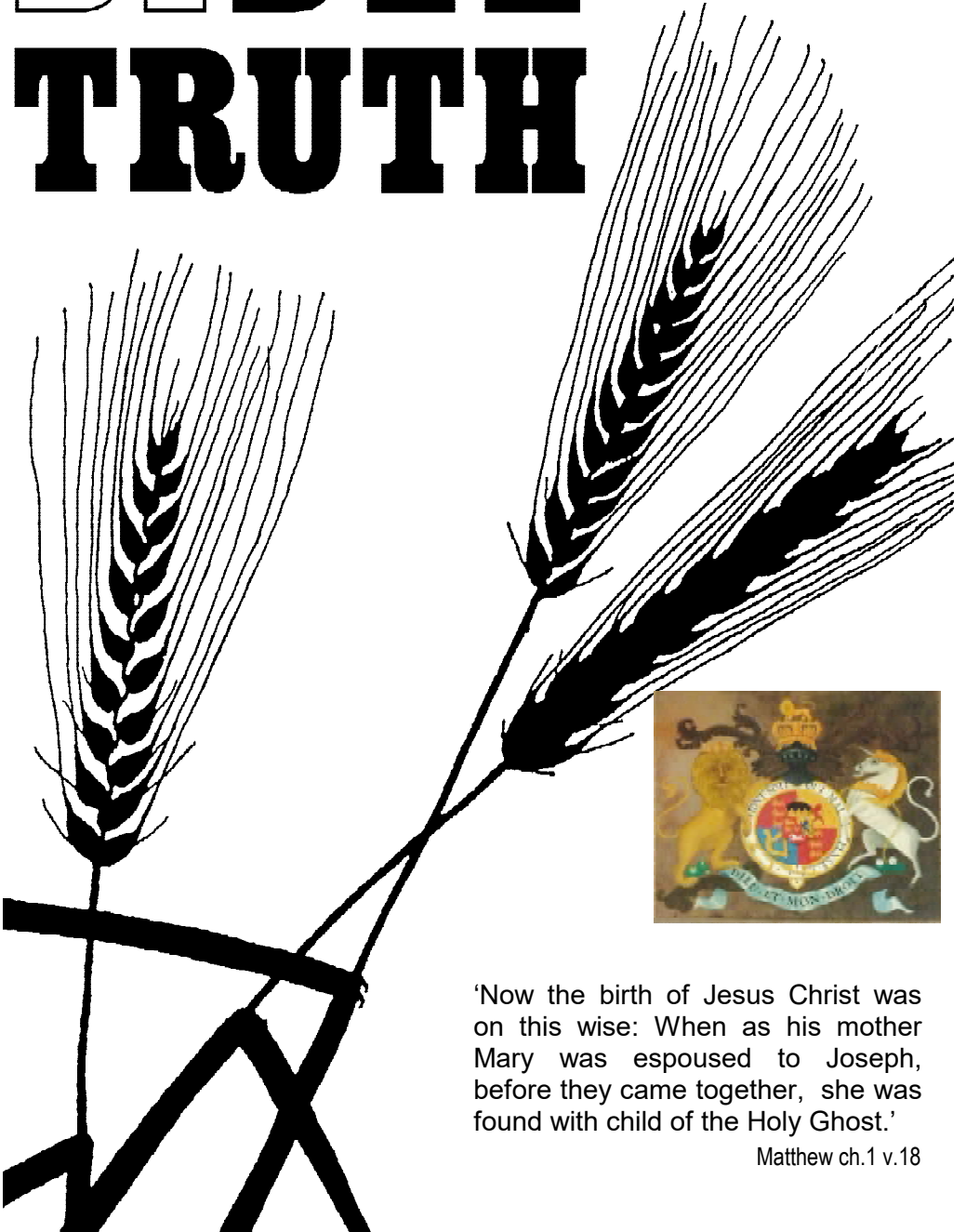

BRIXHAM, Devon

- a West Country town well worth a visit

Brixham nestles below the hills forming the south-west corner of Torbay. This position has sheltered it from south-westerly storms and for centuries provided a safe haven for shipping. At one time it was the largest fishing port in the south west of England and even today it has a sizeable fishing fleet and fish market.

Here William of Orange landed (in 1688) to ascend the throne following the abdication of James II. This is borne out by the inscription below an obelisk standing beside the harbour.

Recently the BIBTF started a successful new meeting here in Market St, not far from the quay.
