

Britain and the European Union

So we finally had a Referendum to decide whether the United Kingdom should remain part of the European Union (EU). As far as God is concerned I did not see it as a choice! Sadly, like the children of Israel who reached a point where they enjoyed the flesh-pots of Egypt, our people had forgotten what life was like, before the EU ... before we had Value Added Tax (VAT), Agricultural and Fishing Policies, before our farmers needed to depend on subsidies ... before the imposition of EU health and safety regulations, and so many other ludicrous directives. Many had forgotten that we were once a Nation, and that we actually had our own Union Jack, instead of a foreign flag on our passports and driving licences. If Turkey, with its 75 million people (mostly Muslims) was to join the EU – it would not be an European Union – it would be an Euro-Asian Union – the beginning of the dream of the one-worlders – a World Union.

Those of us who do remember what it was like when we were truly British, were not persuaded by economic fiction, threats of recession, or World War III. The message of the majority who voted 'leave' was clear– 'WE WANTED OUR COUNTRY BACK!'

As Christians, we should know that Armageddon is inevitable, but it will not happen as a result of us coming out of the European Union. These people did not frighten us – it is they that were scared stiff! They were also utterly hypocritical. Prime Minister David Cameron, for instance, did not want to be part of an European Superstate Dictatorship any more than you or I. Was he trying to scare us into staying in the EU, because he really was having sleepless nights, with nightmares about recession or World War III, and the fear that he and his government would not be able to cope?

The truth is, many of the scaredycat 'remainers' did not really want to be in – but were afraid to come out – it would have been better if they had got their fears under control, and had had the courage to do what they knew was right for Britain!

Of course, Euro-fanatics do have cause to fear that their gravy-train may be derailed, and their prospects of Commissions ruined. Well, perhaps it will put their minds at rest to tell them that, regardless of the result of this Referendum, and contrary to their global

aspirations – THE EU WILL FALL! I understand there are campaigns in Sweden and France to come out of Europe, and they will not be the only ones. It is a failed system that has passed its sell-by date, and it is running out of time. Can you imagine if the money wasted by the EU on first class travel to, and accommodation in, Brussels and Strasbourg, not to mention all the billions involved in running the EU System, were refunded to member states?

It is a fact that, because of sin, Britain is under judgment. Being under the yoke of Euro-Babylon is part of that judgment. Far more important than economic or security issues, is the recovery of our Sovereignty, and beyond that, our Christian heritage.

When Jesus said to the Jews,

‘Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof’,

Matthew ch.21 v.43

He was speaking of a Christian people. Church History tells us that the British Isles were the first nation to become Christian, was first to send out Bibles and missionaries, and has not only given birth to Christianity in other lands, but also to many Christian nations. What kind of world would we live in if it had not been for the missionaries?

Those who study the prophecies of Daniel (ch. 2) and Revelation (chs 13 & 17) know that the succession of powers referred to is Babylon - Medo-Persia - Greece - Rome. Significantly, the Roman Empire was succeeded by the Roman Papacy, which gave power to the Holy Roman Empire, and subsequent powers that existed with the ‘blessing’ of Rome.

A vision of a restored ‘Holy Roman Empire’ was at the heart of forming a European Economic Community (EEC), and signing the Treaty of Rome. We must therefore, recognise the prophetic significance of the EU. The (EEC) was a Nazi plan. The Parliament Building in Strasbourg is incomplete, and is deliberately built to resemble the Tower of Babel, which is confirmed by the EU motto –

‘Europe: many tongues – one voice’.

JUST LIKE THE TOWER OF BABEL – THE EU MUST FALL!


When the European Economic Community was formed, they chose a motif of ‘Europa riding the Bull’ – a Woman riding a Beast – based on ancient Greek and Roman mythology. This image is depicted in a sculpture in front of the Louise Weiss Building in Strasbourg, home of the EU Parliament.

The same image is in a mural inside the EU Parliament building. Another is outside the Council of Europe building in Brussels, and in a large painting inside the EU building. The image appears on various Euro coins, and is starting to appear on the Europa series of Euro bank notes.

Although the EU is apparently secularist and godless, the British Church News on 29th April 2016, referring to the EU stated – ‘It is controlled by Jesuits...’. It is a fact that the Jesuit Office of Catholic Information & Initiative for Europe (OCIPE) set up in 1956, has been at the heart of the political development of the European Union.

Any Christian who believes in, and studies the Bible, should recognise the significance of the Woman riding the Beast.

‘... and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:’

Revelation ch.17 vv 3-4

Another symbol is in the Pergamon Museum in Berlin, Germany. The actual Pergamon Altar – ‘Satan’s seat’ – was excavated and transported in the late 19th century to be displayed in its new home on Museum Island, Berlin, in 1930 (see Revelation ch.2 v.13).

These symbols of the Tower of Babel, Europa riding the Beast, and ‘Satan’s seat’ in the Pergamon Museum, should be enough to alert any Christian to what might be the motivation behind the EU. It is my conviction that the EU is a final attempt to create an image of the Roman beast system. However, I am also amongst those who believe this Tower of Babel will fall – the Adulterous Woman will be destroyed – and Satan’s seat will be overthrown!

It is when Babylon is about to fall, that God says,

‘... Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues’.

Revelations ch.18 v.4

This means there would have to be an opportunity to come out, and because Christians can hear that voice – it suggests that we are being granted the prerogative. Yet it is not a choice, we WILL obey God’s command! Thank God for the promise of His people overcoming Satan.

‘And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.’

Revelation ch.12 vv 10-11

One thing is significant, Israel went into captivity under judgment – in Assyria and Babylon – but it was not until they came out that God began to restore them. It was not until Israel came out of Egypt that God established them as His people. It was not until the remnant of Judah came out of Babylon, that God restored them as a people. They were filled with sadness, their harps were hung on the willow trees but Nehemiah tells us when they returned to Jerusalem, their harps were played again. A joy that will return to this land, especially to the House of God, as harps are taken down from the willow trees, and God brings us out of Euro-Babylon, to revive and restore our Christian heritage. This is a ‘Battle for Britain’. This is not just a contest between two political campaigns and viewpoints. This is a BATTLE with the FORCES OF EVIL ... the DEVIL!

‘Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;’

Ephesians ch.6 vv 10-18

We need to pray earnestly, and as Christians, intercede doing spiritual battle with the enemy of the Christian heritage of our Nation.

I believe we should speak these words, not to misguided politicians who haven’t a clue what’s really going on, not to flesh and blood, but to the forces of darkness and spiritual wickedness, that like Pharaoh of old, are holding this Nation in bondage.

‘... Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, ...’

Let us lay hold on God in faith, and let us believe God —
THIS IS our hour of deliverance!
